

Memorial Policy

The following is a general policy for the Barnstormers in the event that a member or a member's immediate family member (wife, child) dies.

1. Any club member learning of a death should immediately notify a member of the Executive Committee.
2. The Executive Committee will ensure that an appropriate E-mail is sent to the membership to inform them of the death. Such should include the funeral and related arrangements, if known. Members, especially officers, are encouraged to attend or send some expression of sympathy to the survivors, as one would to a friend or neighbor.
3. A flower arrangement of no more than \$100 (and generally smaller) should be sent from the "Tri-County Barnstormers" to the site of any service or viewing with a card so marked. If there is no such event, it will not be necessary to provide flowers.
4. In the event that the survivors specify "no flowers", then we will send none. If a charity is suggested, then a memorial donation check of no more than \$50 may be sent from the "Tri-County Barnstormers" to that charity. No cash donation may be made directly to the survivors without the express approval of the Executive Committee and the membership.
5. In the event that notification is so late that all arrangements have been concluded, then paragraph 2 should apply.
