The Treasurers Report

It's July, the last month in our Fiscal Year 2021 Membership year and our Treasury is doing fine. This is a busy time of the year for me as the invoices for membership dues for 2022 will be going out this month. We currently have 141 members and each of you will receive an email invoice if you have an email address on file, or a mailed invoice for those who refuse to deal with the risks of the Internet.

In any case, dues are for the new membership year which begins August 1st and will end next year on July 31, 2022. Dues are payable by cash, check or money order as we do not accept credit cards, digital currency or homemade money. Members can pay in person at our regular monthly meetings in August, September and October. As a courtesy to Barnstormer members, New Creations RC will accept member dues for the Treasurer to pick up. Please put your check or cash in an envelope with your name on it.

Upon receipt of dues by the Treasurer, paid members will be given the new gate and clubhouse combination for FY2022 and a FY2022 Tri-County Barnstormers member sticker to attach to the back of your AMA card. If you pay in person, at our meetings, you will receive the code and sticker at time of payment. The gate code will be changed at the end of September which is the end of the 60 day grace period for paying dues. Members whose dues are not paid by October meeting will be dropped from the member rolls and may require payment of new Initiation Fee to re-join.

To save postage, the club is sending most dues invoices via email. If you do not pay in person, we have to send your paid invoice by mail to give you the new gate code and member sticker. When opening the mail be careful to not lose the member sticker which is small or forget to keep the invoice which has your gate code attached to it. Do not share the new gate code or forget to spin the lock dials when unlocking the gate or clubhouse locks as they will have the code exposed when initially unlocked. The gate codes are only provided to paid members and not to be shared.

It's time to look at your AMA member card and confirm that you are AMA covered before flying at our field. As an AMA Chartered field we require a valid AMA membership of all flying members. Display your AMA during any preparations or flying as such accidents are covered by your AMA. Fly safe and fly covered by AMA.
