VIII – Noise Policy The membership has adopted a policy of 98 decibels at 3 (three) meters as the maximum permissible noise level of any model flying at the Barnstormers field. Any member not abiding by this noise policy is subject to the grievance procedures as outlined in Article XIV herein.

## Other new business:

Secretary Joe Marquardt proposed holding a club cleanup day at the field to cleanup and cleanout the club house and pump house to be held one weekend in May to be announced at the April meeting. Also proposing the cleanup be combine with a swap-meet at the field.

Next meeting April 1st at 7:30 PM will be conducted as a hybrid meeting with both in person (at the Conroe Community Senior Center@ 1202 Candy Cane Lane (formerly The Friendship Center)) and remote (Zoom) attendance. It is expected that the in-person meeting will resume snacks, raffle, and model awards as per normal meeting agenda items.
